About this programme

This Apprenticeship develops individuals to be able to understand and contribute to creating company culture that is focused on the benefits of continuous improvement, as well as ensuring a safer, more organised workplace. A Lean Manufacturing Operative will be trained to carry out their work safely and meet the exacting quality standards demanded in a fast paced and efficient environment and develop into a multi-skilled member of the team.

Location and duration of training

This Apprenticeship programme will be delivered on your company site and can take up to 18 months to complete.

- Level 2 Diploma in Manufacturing
- Level 1 Functional Skills, English *(If required)*
- Level 1 Functional Skills, Maths *(If required)*



Course Content

This Apprenticeship offers a balance of technical training and on the job assessments to match your organisation's needs and requirements.

Core Knowledge and Skills:

Health & Safety, Environmental, Production, Lean Manufacturing Operations, Quality Control, Problem Solving, Continuous Improvement, Communication and Work Place Organisation

Course Structure

Enrolment/Introduction to Learning

Each learner will take part in an initial enrolment session to ensure the aims, objectives and outcomes of their learning are understood. The enrolment session will offer an opportunity to meet the Group Horizon team who will be on hand throughout the learning journey.

Face to face learning

Throughout the Apprenticeship, learners will be required to attend a series of workshops covering the technical theory, practical sessions and functional skills (English, Maths, if required) elements of their course.

Online/blended learning

- Stretch material for those who wish to dive deeper into topics or for those who demonstrate some prior knowledge or understanding

End Point Assessment (EPA)

The End Point Assessment is split into two assessment methods:

- Observation with question and answers
- Professional discussion

Performance in the EPA will determine the overall Apprenticeship standard grade.
